Heavy-duty pot holder pattern

Instructions for the heavy-duty pot holders

Make sure to use a nice natural fabric for the outer pieces. For the inside batting, you can either use proper batting or upcycle an old towel.

Trace the pattern onto the fabric:

- 2 pieces of outer fabric
- 2 pieces of inner fabric (optional)
- 4 pieces of batting
- 1 piece of binding

You will need:

21 by 42 cm outer fabric21 by 42 cm inner fabric42 by 42 cm batting5 by 70 cm bindingMatching thread

- 1. Layer your fabric: outer fabric inner fabric batting inner fabric outer fabric.
- 2. Secure layers together with pins.
- 3. Start sewing in the middle and sew parallel lines outwards 3 cm apart.
- 4. Iron or press the edges of the binding strip inwards to hide the raw edge.
- 5. Pin the binding so that it evenly covers the raw edge of the pot holder.
- 6. Fold the end of the binding inwards to hide the raw edge over the start of the binding.
- 7. Carefully sew the binding onto the potholder.
- 8. Enjoy your pot holder.
